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## WessDel Supplier Code of Conduct: Compliance with FAR 52.222-50

All suppliers of WessDel are required to comply with the U.S. Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 52.222-50, Combating Trafficking in Persons. This regulation prohibits trafficking in persons and related activities, including but not limited to:

- The recruitment, harboring, transportation, provision, or obtaining of a person for labor or services, through the use of force, fraud, or coercion.
- Procuring commercial sex acts during the performance of the contract.
- Using forced labor in the performance of the contract.
- Destroying, concealing, confiscating, or otherwise denying access to an employee's identity or immigration documents.
- Using misleading or fraudulent recruitment practices.
- Charging employees recruitment fees.
- Failing to provide or pay for return transportation costs for employees brought to a country for the purpose of working on a U.S. government contract or subcontract.
- Providing or arranging housing that fails to meet the host country's housing and safety standards.

Suppliers are required to include the substance of FAR 52.222-50 in all subcontracts and contracts with agents, and to ensure that their subcontractors at all tiers also comply with these requirements. Suppliers must also develop and implement a compliance plan if they are providing supplies, other than commercially available off-the-shelf items, acquired outside the United States, or services to be performed outside the United States.

Suppliers must report any credible information they receive about potential violations of FAR 52.222-50 to WessDel management or the contracting officer. WessDel reserves the right to take appropriate action against suppliers who violate this policy, including termination of contracts or referral to law enforcement authorities.
